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going to ask you the specific amount unless you can look at the chart later. Is it going to be increased also?

SENATOR SCHROCK: If the Game and Parks Commissioners decide to increase it and hold a hearing on it, then they can increase it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So when we look at what is put in the bill before us as an increase in the fishing license, there is an additional amount that you have to pay before you can fish which is not included in the cost of the license. Is that true?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, it's...

SPEAKER BROMM: Time. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and I'd like to continue, if Senator Schrock will.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now, Senator Schrock,...

SENATOR SCHROCK: And there's a stamp I haven't told you about too, if you want to know about that one.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, which one is that?

SENATOR SCHROCK: It's the migratory stamp. It's a federal stamp that's required to hunt migratory birds.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Well, that was...the cost of that would be set by the federal government, or the state?

SENATOR SCHROCK: I believe that's the case. I can't say with certainty, but...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, so let's deal with what partners in crime at the state level are responsible for. (Laugh)
