Legislature, I need time to ask questions and since Senator Schrock has...oh, I don't see him. I will...oh, I see him. I'd like to ask Senator Schrock a question or two, if he will be of assistance.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Schrock, will you yield?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, I will.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Schrock, does the university have a staff that includes veterinarians?

SENATOR SCHROCK: I would think that there's veterinarians on staff that are part of the Institute of Agriculture and Natural Resources.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And are they located in different parts of the state, would they be?

SENATOR SCHROCK: I believe that's true.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Does the Department of Agriculture have veterinarians?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, they do.

SPEAKER BROMM: I'm sorry, Senator Chambers. The call is raised.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, that's all right.

SPEAKER BROMM: Pardon me.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, so the university has veterinarians in various parts of the state. Would the veterinarians of the Department of Agriculture be in various parts of the state, or would they at least serve various parts of the state?
