PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Landis. Further discussion? If not, the Chair would recognize Senator Schrock to close on his amendment. Senator Schrock waives closing. The question is the adoption of the Schrock amendment to LB 306. All those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Schrock's amendment.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Stuhr would move to amend with AM0119. (Legislative Journal page 333.)

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: The Chair would recognize Senator Stuhr.

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. This amendment reduces the proposed cap into half. And it's quite a lengthy amendment, as you will see. But what this means, actually, is that the commission will probably come back in three or four years instead of the last ten that was...that we noted was 1993, the last time that we addressed this issue. I reluctantly offer this amendment, but do ask for your support.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Stuhr. Further discussion? Seeing none, the Chair would recognize Senator Stuhr to close on her amendment. She waives closing. The question is the adoption of AM0119 to LB 306. All those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Stuhr's amendment.
