SENATOR CHAMBERS: But Game and Parks is not the pitiful, little, poor, impoverished agency that people give the impression about this morning that if we don't increase these fees then the parks are going to pot.

SENATOR SCHROCK: No, I don't think...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That's not true, is it?

SENATOR SCHROCK: But I don't think we've tried to portray it that way, whether it's been Senator Wehrbein or myself. You know, Game and Parks is quite an organization.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I was told last session, when I fought against this fee bill and they had to take it out of the other bill, that if they didn't get that increase that the parks were going to fall into disrepair. That's what I was told and I said I didn't believe it, and now I know it was a lie because they haven't fallen into disrepair and they didn't get this last session. We're told that all the time--the fear, the specter that people are not going to evaluate or examine. So you all accept it on this bill and steamroll over me, but when you bring your education bills, when Senator Wehrbein brings his...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...mainline budget bill, will he be able to get 33 votes at the very beginning to accept what he presents to us? Because the only thing you're going to vote on, if you get cloture, is the committee amendment and then the bill, and I'll have a host of amendments up there and you will take that budget the way they bring it out. And maybe the budget committee should accept that and put in it what they want. Otherwise, you may not get to vote on the budget bill and we'll come back for a special session. This doesn't mean anything to you all. Well, what you all talk about means not much to me. I don't care about that university. It's not a great thing for black people, either students or employees, so what do I care about the university? And I've been foolish, probably, to take that
