SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...confined to my district. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, that was your third time, Senator Chambers, and there are no further lights on. You're recognized to close on your amendment, FALL49, if you care to.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I don't believe that an amendment that I offer at this time is going to be adopted by the body. I have to give Game and Parks credit. They do their work and they know this Legislature. They know how lacking in concern this Legislature is. And although those people on that commission don't get paid, the kind of influence and the benefits that can accrue to them and the ones they care about by being on that commission explains to you why they fight so hard to be there and why they don't want proportional or "populationwise" representation on that commission. That is the goose that lays the golden egg that's at the top of the beanstalk, and when somebody comes to the top of that beanstalk and wants to go to that gold, I am the one that the giant looks at and says, fe-fi-fo-fum, be he alive or be he dead, I'll grind his bones to make my bread. Why do you think these rich people want to be on that commission? Why do you think Gene Mahoney and those kind of people are lionized and honored in the way that they are? This is not a common people's Game and Parks Commission that does things with the common people in mind. Well, you've got to get their money to subsidize some of the things that the fat cats want but that they don't want to pay for. Harold Andersen would be totally opposed to what I'm saying. He's a former publisher of the Omaha World-Herald. He's in that circle, and they don't bear looking into too closely. But I'm going to fight today and tomorrow and until you all get tired of me fighting and you decide to throw down the gauntlet and cloture me.
