January 30, 2003 LB 4-7

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 4 pass? All those in favor vote aye, and those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 358.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 4 does pass. LB 5.

CLERK: (Read LB 5 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 5 pass? All those in favor vote aye, and those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 358-359.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 5 passes. LB 6.

CLERK: (Read LB 6 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 6 pass? All those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 359.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 6 does pass. Members, the first vote with respect to LB 7 is whether to dispense with Final Reading of LB 7. All those in favor vote aye, and those opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 42 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, to dispense with the at-large reading.
