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hearing, from absolutely requiring a notice, as we do in most cases for hearings, to notice if possible. And I guess I would have a couple of questions with regard to that. First of all, if it's important enough to have a hearing, isn't it important enough to give people notice of the hearing, would be my first question. And why...and what does "if possible" mean? Does it mean...does it relate to when they discover the error? And if so, how do we know when they discover the error? Or what does "if possible" mean in that context? Those would be my two questions, and I would give you my time to respond.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Would you yield, Senator Vrtiska?

SENATOR VRTISKA: Senator Beutler, I have to be honest with you. I had the same thoughts when I was addressing this bill. And I didn't touch upon it because it's...I don't really have an answer for what...why it was changed from...it was changed from a special meeting to a regular meeting. And then the wording "if possible" was added. You know, I don't have a big problem with striking that part if you feel it would be the right thing to do. I had some question. And I apologize for not going to the legal counsel for the Association of County Officials and get some idea so I could have addressed that today. And it should have been done. It wasn't done in the committee, and I overlooked even talking about it. But I had the same question, and I apologize for not getting...and if you feel like something should be done, I'm receptive to an amendment if you think that would be necessary. I don't know what...why "if possible" was added to this particular change in this particular bill. And I really need to talk to the legal counsel from the...who represents the county assessors and the County Officials Association to find out why that was done.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator, I appreciate your openness on the matter. And obviously, it's no huge deal. But maybe if we could discuss it after General File...

SENATOR VRTISKA: I was just going to suggest...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...and with the other folks that are interested, we could see why they thought that was necessary.
