SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members of the body. I have several questions I'd like to address to Senator Baker.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker, would you yield to a question, please?

SENATOR STUHR: Senator Baker, I believe at the beginning of the amendment it says, strike Section 1 in its entirety. Now, I'm looking on part (4) of Section 1, which gives a definition of a farm site. Where in the amendment is that definition, because I believe you said it was included? I couldn't seem to find it.

SENATOR BAKER: That's in existing statutes in another section. It's not in here.

SENATOR STUHR: In what section would that be?

SENATOR BAKER: I...that I can't answer. It's...we're not taking definition of a farm site out of the statutes. It's not mentioned in this particular amendment, but it's in there someplace else. And that's one of the questions I wanted to find out for myself, between now and Select File.

SENATOR STUHR: Yes. Also, another question in relationship to Section 2. The language that is struck in the bill, does that remain? I don't believe that...

SENATOR BAKER: I'm not sure where you're referring to Section 2.

SENATOR STUHR: Section 2 of the original bill. The language that is struck there, does that remain?

SENATOR BAKER: No, it does not.

SENATOR STUHR: All right.

SENATOR BAKER: I don't think it does. I think I follow what you're asking. It does not remain in there
