don't have your driver's license, but you own a driver's license, do they send you home to get it, or do you get a special qualifying number?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: You have to provide it in person.

SENATOR BEUTLER: All right. So if you've been issued a driver's license, then they won't give you a number until you...or they won't register you or give you a number. You have to go home and get it.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: That is correct. And I'm assuming at that point they might let you complete your registration form and then mail in the copy of the valid registration, but I don't know that for sure. I think...committee counsel says she thinks you need to complete it.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. So you give the driver's license number or the last four digits of your Social Security number?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER: So it's one or the other?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: If you can do neither one of those then you are assigned an identification number by the county clerk.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. And the last four digits of your Social Security number, I assume you have to produce your Social Security card?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: It doesn't say that, Senator.

SENATOR BEUTLER: You mean, I could just verbally give the last four numbers of my Social Security number?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I believe so, um-hum.

SENATOR BEUTLER: So if I knew the long driver's license number, I could verbally give the driver's license number also, I suppose, huh?
