SENATOR SCHIMEK: That is my understanding.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Well, let me think about that. The other last question I have, with regard to the prohibition on spending General Funds...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: May I add to that?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Sure.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I believe you could give it verbally, but you would have to write it on the form, or the county clerk would. It would have to be written on the form, and that allows them...

SENATOR BEUTLER: So you'd be subject to...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...to cross-match if they need to with the voter...with the drivers database, the drivers...Motor Vehicles' database.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. On this bill and the previous bill, LB 358, the phrase with regard to the prohibition of General Funds was not in either bill, right?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The phrase...it wasn't in the last bill, but it is...

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: One minute.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...in this bill. Is that right? Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: It is in this bill?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. So it...but it's still, if I'm remembering your response earlier, it's still your intention that with regard to all three bills...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: No General Funds.
