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SENATOR HARTNETT: Um-hum.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...and we will be able to help them do some of that kind of thing.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: And if I...would you mind if I would...

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah, go ahead, if you would.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...use some of your time?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah. Yeah.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Because I did find the answer to Senator Hudkins' question and apparently, Senator Hudkins, it is an ongoing number, that you do keep the same number. So I've never had any question about it before, never ever thought about it in terms of my own license, but, yes, you do keep the same number.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Chair recognizes Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Are there any other lights on?

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: No.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: May I close then?

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Senator Schimek, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Mr. President and members. I appreciate all your attention and all your good questions about these three bills. I think...I mean, I think that this is an important issue and that we will be talking about it over the next several years so that I hope that everybody is able to get up to speed on some of these more important issues. With that, I'd just like to thank you for your attention and ask you to advance this to E & R Initial.
