CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 35.

CLERK: I do, Mr. President. Thank you. Your Committee on Government reports LR 16CA to General File, LB 114 General File, LB 257 General File, LB 331 General File, LB 99 General File with amendments, LB 77 indefinitely postponed, likewise with LB 88 and LB 330. Revenue Committee reports LR 18CA to General File with committee amendments attached. And Urban Affairs Committee reports LB 52 to General File, LB 150 General File with amendments, LB 365 General File with amendments; all those reports signed by their respective committee chairs.
