to discharge the duties imposed upon the Attorney General's Office. I'm not aware of other causes of action involving the Attorney General's Office where the Attorney General's Office recovers lawyer fees. I'd like to ask Senator Schrock a question or two.

SENATOR ENGEL: Senator Schrock, would you yield?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Schrock, as you go to your desk, I'm going to pose this question. I see that somebody from the Attorney General's Office testified before your committee. Did that person tell the committee any other actions that are brought by the Attorney General's Office under which the office recovers attorney fees?

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: I appreciate the anointment, Senator Chambers, but I'm not familiar with any others.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And just so we can have a discussion back and forth for the record, if you don't mind.
