fight that. That's one of the reasons I'm reluctant to let this bill move, so I'd like to ask Senator Schrock a question, and I put my light on for the last time in case we cannot finish. Senator Schrock, is some form of the committee amendment going to be presented to us where the Attorney General's Office will derive money by filing actions under this bill? Is that going to be?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Senator Chambers, I can't speak with certainty on this, but I think if the Attorney General does file action on behalf of an NRD, the only portion that I would want them to derive money from would be to recover their cost, not...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But not an attorney's fee?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Not an...I think that would be agreeable. I would agree with you, not attorney's fees, recover their cost.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That doesn't bother me as much, so having said that, I will not have to speak on the bill again, and I will not have anything further to do with it at this stage. Thank you, Senator Schrock.

SENATOR ENGEL: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Schrock, you're recognized.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, and members of the Legislature, I appreciate Senator Chambers' and Senator Beutler's involvement. In consultation with the NRDs...and I will, prior to this bill being on Select File, give anyone here a copy of the amendment we would bring, and especially Senator Chambers and Senator Beutler. There are some actions out there that are unintentional and are minor that maybe a misdemeanor is the proper way to address it. This is not an act intended to use a heavy club on some poor individual whose employee tampers with a meter on a well and without them knowing about it. I don't even think the NRD would bring that kind of charge. This is to get the bad actor out there who un...who knowingly violates cease and desist orders.
