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SENATOR BEUTLER: And the second thing is you might want to look at the language of the bill because it's a little bit confusing. It says that you can apply once for one center.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: In other words, you can't apply multiple times for one facility. But it doesn't say that you can't come back and apply for a second kind of facility, as I read it, and you might want to look at that and see if you don't agree.

SENATOR JANSSEN: I probably...it probably does say that, Senator, but I think that you have to make that grant application to the group that administers that and, if you have had one, I doubt very much whether you would get another one again; that, you know, in my perspective. It doesn't say that.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah. Well, maybe, you know, another alternative would be to add to the factors that are laid out in the current law, the factor that if you've already applied and received a grant you're not due up again until such and such happens, or whatever.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Forty or fifty years or something like that.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah. (Laugh)

SENATOR JANSSEN: That's a good idea. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Janssen. We're discussing AM0176 offered by Senator Aguilar to LB 385. Open for discussion yet on that. Senator Bourne, followed by Senators Connealy, and Beutler, and Aguilar, and Tyson. Senator Bourne.

SENATOR BOURNE: Good morning or, excuse me, I was talking to Senator Aguilar. Thank you, Mr. President. Members, I rise in opposition to Senator Aguilar's amendment. We had discussed this issue in committee and it was suggested by a particular interest group that we raise this limit, and we had some excellent testimony from smaller communities that an amendment
