He may convince me, but right now I think one point that he may be missing is the fact the fair, you know, it's a place where we can go. It's a place where Jim Cudaback can go or where a poor man, or a place like Warren Buffett can go. We don't know the difference. We do not know the difference. The poor people can go there and spend, what, three or four bucks of admission? I don't know what it costs. But you can go spend a whole day and we don't care who we're walking by, who we're sipping an ice cream cone by or a Coke or whatever. We...it doesn't matter. We're all one walking down through the halls, walking through the Devaney Center there, looking at the toys. We're all one. It doesn't matter whether you're rich, whether you're poor. That's what I like about it. You can be...you're just you. You can wear tattered clothes, you can wear a suit, you can wear anything. You don't really care. You're just you. I guess you can tell what my feelings, I don't need to express them I guess, but you're you. Warren Buffett, you know, he's just an ordinary guy. He's ordinary anyhow so I shouldn't say that. But we're all one. We're all one there. And I don't think we could really change this if we wanted to. I think time dictates here. You can't fool the public. You can't fool the public.
