up...reinspections. That's if they have to come out. The first inspection is \$15 to \$50. If they have to come out, somebody makes a mistake, they have to come out and reinspect it, it goes up from \$20 to \$75. And then if they don't get it corrected then, it goes from \$20 to \$100. I guess you pay for your mistake. Owner requested inspections: \$10 to \$30. And this is...this goes on and on this way. It simply puts it in tune with the times. Like I say, nobody really wants to raise. But since 1987, what's that, 15-16 years, haven't increased it. I suppose they'll be back again in five or six more. They...oh, I should point out, they can lower it if they don't need this money. And they probably...they may not go up the full limit here, but they can lower it too, if they have to. Although we know this won't happen. I mean, I don't think it will happen, unless we have a deflation instead of inflation, which is probably not going to happen. Which...I guess I shouldn't say "won't happen." It happened to my stocks and your stocks, so I guess we can deflate. But anyway, for this purposes, inflation has taken over. You want less inspectors? You don't want to inspect the machinery and the technologies required more and more, and is probably going to require more down the road. So if you want to do with less, I guess, don't vote for the bill. If you want to keep up with the times, why, vote for LB 126. And with that, why, if you have any questions, why, feel free to ask me.
