responsibility, meaning the totaled-out vehicle, in this case, an ATV, responsibility to comply with this section. The owner shall, within ten days after the settlement of the loss, forward the properly endorsed acceptable certificate of title to the county clerk or designated county official in the county designated in Section 6, which would be where the vehicle is registered. The county clerk or designated county official shall, upon receipt of the certificate of title, issue a salvage branded certificate of title for this, what we'd call totaled-out vehicle. It simply harmonizes what we do with other vehicles, and applies this to all-terrain vehicles. With that, I'd be glad to answer any questions. If there are none, I'd urge adoption of this amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Baker. Senator Burling, you are recognized to speak.

SENATOR BURLING: Thank you, Madam Chair and members of the body. You know, I wanted to thank Senator Baker for bringing this to my attention. I looked at it. I fully support the amendment. And I'd urge the body to adopt it.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you. Is there further discussion on the amendment? Seeing none, Senator Baker is recognized to close. He waives closing. So the question is the adoption of AM0193 to LB 333. All those in favor vote aye; all opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Baker's amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The amendment is adopted. Now we are back to discussion on the bill. Senator Quandahl, you are recognized to speak.
