SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Governor (sic), members, I think the public, I think the people from out of state, I think they expect to pay a higher rate than if within. I won't prolong this. I won't talk about it a lot. We talked about it the other evening with some people. I talked about it with my constituents. We talked about raising the rates between Nebraskans. And somebody suggested to me in Gothenburg, said, why don't you...we have a lot of people come from Colorado, not that you're picking on them, from Wyoming, whatever...but, said, why don't you charge them a higher rate being as they don't pay the general tax levy that we pay here? And I...it's reasonable as long, as long as, this person said, don't gouge them, and I don't think this is a gouge. You know, they're paying a little bit more because they're from out of state, and they appreciate our lakes and so on here, and what's wrong with that?

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Further discussion? Seeing none, the Chair would recognize Senator Schrock to close. Senator Schrock waives closing. Question is the adoption of AM0246 to LB 122. All those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Schrock's amendment.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: The amendment is adopted. Further amendments?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Chair would recognize Senator Mossey for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. Lieutenant Governor, I move the advancement of LB 122 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Mossey. You've heard the motion. The question for the body is the advancement of LB 122. All those in favor please say aye. All those opposed say nay. Bill is advanced. Next item, Mr. Clerk.
