an agronomist to determine what the best management is within that. Then they could say...put their stamp of approval on it, say, this is the way we want to do it. Then they would have some teeth to come back and say, if you're not doing that, they could impose some fines, just like if you would the date, time, I think. So, thank you. I would support the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Kremer. Senator Schrock, there are no further lights on. Did you wish to close on your amendment?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Just to say that the certified crop consultants, or agronomists in this case, are responsible people. And if they give wrong recommendations, they can lose their certification. So they are pretty much monitored, and they're professional people. And if they are not making the right recommendations, they can lose their certification.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. You've heard the closing on AM0238 to LB 93. All in favor of AM0238 being adopted vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the adoption of AM0238 to LB 93. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Schrock's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment was adopted.

CLERK: Senator Mossey, I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 93 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to advance to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk, next item.
