collection is a coming issue for which there is not now, that I know of, a rule. I could be wrong on that, but I'll check. But I think the answer is, that's coming. We don't have a rule now, and we can expect a rule, you know, will be established, and we'll have to choose, you know, whether to comply or not.

SENATOR JONES: Okay. Thank you, Senator Landis. I really appreciate what you're doing here, because I get more talk about this back at coffee shops than anything else, why we're not collecting sales tax from other states. So I think we're in this...going in the right direction here, and hopefully we can get this on through and support it. But there's still a lot of questions. I realize that. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jones. Senator Bromm.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. President. I want to commend the Tax Commissioner for the leadership and competence in helping lead us to this point on this particular issue. I think it's a vital issue that we get our hands around this and get a system in place. It is...we don't do business in the way we've always done business. And that is part of the reason why we have an eroding tax base and we don't have such a dynamic amount of revenue to draw from in balancing our budget. Senator Landis, I have a quick question for you, if you would yield, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Would you respond, Senator Landis?

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Landis, in the last year or so I know I have heard several people mention, and I've probably even repeated this myself, that there is a congressional moratorium on the collection of tax, or sales tax on certain aspects of the Internet. And I have been under the impression that that might be some sort of a stumbling block in this whole process. But I haven't...I didn't hear your discussion Thursday, but I haven't heard that mentioned. So I take it that it must not be. And if you know the details of that, I would ask you to clarify that for us.
