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clothing, whatever. Another issue was brought up was sales tax holidays in some of the states are popular. These retailers need to know if they're shipping a particular item that it is taxed, or if they'd have a specific set of days that are sales tax-free, back-to-school promotion, things like that. The biggest task I see is getting uniform definitions into this. The cost of the software, as I recall, is going to be borne by the states. And that, of course, was one of the factors that figured into withdrawal. If we withdrew and things...we still had outstanding costs involved with setting it up, then we'd be assessed our particular share of the cost. Repeating once again, it takes ten states with 20 percent of the population to get this thing up and actually working. The rationale behind that, of course, is they don't want to do it for one or two states. The cost effectiveness of that is not good. So I also and I don't know as I have that map I know I don't have my file. But it's basically a block of states, a pretty solid block, from north-south line through Nebraska east. The glaring lack is Colorado, as I recall. And this is off the top of my head. Colorado did not join this. But I think all the other bordering states around Nebraska did. So I think it's something that deserves a lot of discussion. It's had a lot of discussion here on the floor, and I commend Senator Landis for being able to answer these questions. He has all these things in his head. I have to look them up. But certainly it's a bill that I support, and I think it's something we need to go ahead and advance to Select File. And if there are questions developed between now and then, fine, we'll answer them at that time. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Baker. Senator Brown.

SENATOR BROWN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator Landis had agreed to check into something for me, and I wondered if he would be willing to yield to a question.
