Senator Redfield had put this as the date of execution. However, the sales tax is a destination tax and the good arrives at its destination at delivery, and so, I think with her agreement, the Tax Commissioner suggested that we make this date of effectiveness to be on the date of delivery; what was the sales tax at the time of delivery. That was the committee amendment and I think everyone agreed to it. There was... Scott Sullivan appeared on behalf of the Members Only Auto Club (sic). There was no opposition, no neutral. The bill was advanced 7 to 1 by the committee, and I think the committee amendment was adopted unanimously. I would ask for the adoption of the committee amendment to make this date the date of delivery.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Heard the opening on the committee amendments to LB 381. Open for discussion on those amendments. Senator Redfield.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. I am in support of the amendment. It makes it consistent with our other language on the sales tax and, in fact, the contracts are signed at delivery, so it accomplishes the purpose of the bill. Thank you, Senator Landis, for explaining it.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Redfield. Are there any others wishing to speak to the committee amendments? I do not see any lights on. Senator Landis, did you wish to close? He waives that opportunity to close. The question for the body is adoption of the committee amendments to LB 381. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on adoption of the committee amendments, the committee amendments to LB 381. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Committee amendments are adopted. Back to discussion of the bill itself, LB 381, to E & R Initial. Senator Beutler.
