February 10, 2003 LB 66, 205

SENATOR CUDABACK: The committee amendments are adopted. Back to discussion of the bill itself, the advancement of LB 205 to E & R Initial. Open for discussion. Senator Janssen, there are no lights on. Did you wish to close on the advancement?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Simply to say, Senator Cudaback, that this is a simple bill. It allows wholesalers the right to sample the same way as the retailers do at the present time. It was advanced out of the committee clean, so I just ask for your support. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Janssen. You've heard the closing on the advancement of LB 205. The question before the body is, shall LB 205 be advanced to E & R Initial? All in favor of the motion vote aye, and opposed nay. Voting on advancement of LB 205. We are voting on the advancement of LB 205 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted? Senator Janssen, I'm sorry,...

SENATOR JANSSEN: Never mind.

SENATOR CUDABACK: ...I couldn't hear you.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Never mind.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 205 does advance. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.

ASSISTANT CLERK: LB 66 was introduced by Senator Raikes. (Read title.) Bill was read for the first time on January 9, referred to the Education Committee. That committee reports the bill to General File with no committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Raikes, you're recognized to open on advancement of LB 66.
