SENATOR ENGEL: Thank you very much, Senator Johnson. The Chair recognizes Senator Kruse.

SENATOR KRUSE: Mr. President and members, there was a...just to respond to a couple of these thoughts, there was the thought or kind of an outside question as to whether or not a family might be faced with some expenses that they really had not anticipated or they'd have...they'd be ambivalent about paying. That is never the case. I have been in literally hundreds of these situations and we have never had a financial burden that went to the family. And then just to underline what Dr. Johnson, to use that term today, is saying, unless you have stood in some of these places, you cannot imagine the tension and emotions that is sometimes there. I've had family members who were so angry in their grief that they attacked the nurse. This is not a time for rational discussion. This is not a time to make those decisions. And I...it's obvious that we're going to give support to this and I urge that we do so thinking also of the families, that they might be eased through this very tense time. Thank you.

SENATOR ENGEL: Thank you, Senator Kruse. The Chair recognizes Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I'm not willing to let go of the issue that was raised by Senator Redfield. What I think ought to be done, since we're dealing with a very serious issue, is to notify everybody, who has agreed to be a donor, that the law is changing and the family members will have nothing to say about whether or not this donation will take effect. Is it still your wish that you be a donor, knowing that nobody, after you die...notice I'm trying to be delicate in what I say. I usually say croak because I believe in being realistic and nothing is more realistic and final than croaking. Senator Engel, don't be shook up. I'm an old frog and the only thing an old frog can do
