SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes. Thank you. Mr. President, members, I think this is an educational process for all of us this morning. I did pass out this sheet. And it actually was prepared and sent out by Legislative Research, if you'll look on the last page, on January 2003, and it's supposed to be up-to-date as of December 2002. I have asked somebody from Legislative Research to come up and talk to me about this. But Senator Stuthman, I didn't hear all of your comments, but I would like to ask you a question or two, just for points of clarification. Now, it's my understanding that Banner County, for instance, on this sheet, has developed a comprehensive plan. That's what it says here. But it doesn't say...and it says that that's what their previous zoning status was. It doesn't say, over in that right-hand column, that their plan and their zoning regulations have been adopted. Am I reading that right, would you say?

SPEAKER BROMM Senator Stuthman

SENATOR STUTHMAN I think am I on now? Okay. Yes, I think you are right there. The comprehensive development plan. They're in the process of developing the plan.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Right.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: But anything...there is nothing that can be built or put on that county while there is being a plan developed, because they can't get any approval to do such an expansion or construction while the plan is being developed.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: And I believe that's right. And that is why we allowed, at one point, some interim zoning regulations to be in place, so the counties could get in the position where that is true. But at the same time, there are 12 of these counties, as I read this list, that haven't actually...there are actually 16. Four of them aren't doing anything at all, and the other 12 are in the process somewhere. Would you say that's an accurate statement?

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Yes, I would say that...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: If this information is correct.
