transmission built by another builder, and a rear axle built by someone else, Freightliner will have to pay when the other manufacturer refuses. The truck manufacturer has selected these partners, and should not be allowed to pass the expense of their warranties onto the dealer without paying for them. This bill is limited to those three major component parts, because we are reacting to current industry practices, and at this time it does not appear to be necessary to include smaller and less expensive items. I ask for your support in advancing this to Select File. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Aguilar. Is there any discussion on the committee amendments to LB 371? Seeing none, Senator Baker, these are the committee amendments. You're recognized to close on the committee amendments if you wish.
