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floor, and that the committee amendment was going to be adequate to deal with the concerns. The major concern, as I'm hearing it now, is a fear that establishments might be harassed by individuals who will...in effect, will be that person called the "affected party", that may institute an action. I think possibly this definition can be narrowed between now and Select File. Technically, in the law now, that action can be filed with a court for injunctive relief. And it's just...it's hardly happening. We don't have the actual numbers of the instances that these...this relief is being asked for in the court. But it's very, very small at the present time. But there is some necessity here, to hold facilities accountable. And we don't...Senator Hartnett, this is not just feel-good legislation. The committee amendment isn't just feel-good. If you don't have any kind of way to enforce accountability on the part of the facility, they can basically just thumb their nose at the law, and it doesn't...you know, it has no effect. And this isn't legislation that we should be passing in this legislature unless we really have the courage, the backbone to enforce it. But I think we've come to a place where we do truly have enforcement. With the committee amendment, I think we have agreement, at least at this point, with past legislation on what and who is affected. We...I hope Senator Janssen has had his question asked relative to what happens to individuals that violate. A person that violates is guilty of a Class V misdemeanor. The facility is...everybody is bending over backwards to try to accommodate them. You have to go to court to get injunctive relief relative to those individuals. But we'll work on this. I'm sure Senator Jensen has made himself totally available, as has the committee, to make sure we get the kinks worked out of this. And he feels, as the majority of the committee does, that we do need this enforcement issue. So I would pledge the Chair and the Vice Chair to work on this language between now and Select File. I think it can be handled. And I would encourage you to move the committee amendments.
