SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Thompson, would you yield?

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yes. Actually, the only thing that's in is striking Section 71-5705, those three words.

SENATOR BOURNE: No, 5707.

SENATOR THOMPSON: 707. Excuse me.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay. So what we're dealing with now and what we're going to vote to advance on is this language: the Department of Health and Human Services Regulation and Licensure, a local board of health, or any affected party may institute an action in any court with jurisdiction to enjoin any violation of the Nebraska Clean Indoor Air Act.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Correct.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay. So earlier we had some people discussing this, that before it only applied to the businesses.

SENATOR THOMPSON: No.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay. Before it only applied to the individual?

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yes.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay. And now what you're going to do is apply it to any business that's subject to the Nebraska Clean Indoor Air Act?

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yes.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Well, actually, ...yes. I'm sorry. Both.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay. So...and again, I...you know, I'm familiar with this issue just cursory, I guess, because of, you know, past bills and that. But as I understand it, there's some
