SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. You've heard the opening on AM0306 offered by Senator Beutler to LB 217. Now open for discussion, Senator Quandahl.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Members of the body, I would agree with Senator Beutler on this when he said this isn't a huge deal and it's not integral to the entire bill. And what the Department of Banking believed was that a postconveyance approval would be sufficient, and they just merely wanted to clarify the law to make it clear that a resolution would not be approved. What Senator Beutler's amendment simply would do is just leave the law the way that it is currently, and I don't have any objection to that. And I would urge the adoption of AM0306.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Quandahl. Anybody else wishing to speak to the Beutler amendment. Seeing no lights on, Senator Beutler. Senator Beutler waives closing.
