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is different. So what do those prayers mean and who are the people encompassed by those prayers? The ones who pray them make that determination, but if they're praying to the one they say they're praying to, I'm sure there's not a rejection by him,...

SPEAKER BROMM: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...her, or them of any of their children.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President and members I need to stand and say I certainly support the issue that Senator Chambers is advocating here, and I realize that it's not going to become an amendment on this bill. But, Senator Chambers, I've been on Business and Labor Committee a number of years and this issue keeps coming back every year and it keeps either not getting out of committee, and I don't know if it's ever gotten out of committee, but if it does, it doesn't get out in time to have anything happen to it on the floor. I guess I'm curious, and I didn't hear all your comments, Senator, so I just want to know for my own information, has this bill been heard yet by the Business and Labor Committee and, if so, has a vote been taken on the bill?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It has been heard, Senator Schimek. No vote, as yet, has been taken.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay. So it's conceivable that this bill could yet come to the floor, or have you got the votes pretty well counted and you don't think it will?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: It is conceivable and I haven't counted the votes.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay. That's all I wanted to know. Thank you very much.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.
