February 18, 2003 LB 150, 365

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Madam President and members of the body, and I certainly concur with the committee. I think that this is a clarifying amendment. It helps clarify that confusion between some agencies, such as the state agency requiring an annual one, some of the federal ones biannual, and this just simply clarifies that language. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you. Is there further discussion on the amendment? Seeing none, the question is then the adoption of AM0116 to LB 150. All of those in favor say aye, all of those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of committee amendments, Madam President.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you. The committee amendments are adopted. We now go back to the discussion of LB 150. Seeing no lights, Senator Stuhr, would you wish to close on your bill?

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Madam President and members of the body. Just one comment. As I said earlier, this merely changes the date from six months to nine months, and we did check with the State Auditor. She has no problem...or the State Auditor has no problem with this change, and I ask for your support. Thank you.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Stuhr. The question is the advancement of LB 150 to E & R Initial. All of those in favor vote aye; all of those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Madam President.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The bill advances. Next item for the record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Madam President, LB 365 was introduced by Senator Mines. (Read title.) Bill was read for the first time on January 14, referred to the Urban Affairs Committee. That committee reports the bill to General File with committee
