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Mr. Schrock.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, would you respond to a question?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, I will, Senator Stuthman. Your concerns are warranted, but I will tell you that the issues you are talking about are covered by the Livestock Waste Management Act. This bill is strictly for those people who install septic tanks. And that would be for domestic type of use. And so it's a whole different area. This does not concern livestock waste management, which, obviously, your pits that you have for hog facilities and for cattle facilities, that's a whole different section of law, whole different act. And so this would not pertain to livestock waste management.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: So in other words, what I am understanding with this bill, that this bill only pertains to septic tanks and personal wastewater. Am I correct?

SENATOR SCHROCK: That is correct.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Stuthman. On with discussion. Senator Hartnett on committee amendments to LB 94.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. President, members of the body, it probably deals with the bill itself. But Senator Schrock, as long as we're on the...we might as well about it now. Say that I move to the country (laugh), and...

SENATOR SCHROCK: If you move to the...

SENATOR HARTNETT: ...and there's a lot of septic tanks in my county, Sarpy County, and I want to...I build a home out, I have no...you know, I'm going to use the septic tanks. What's the process that I have to go through to get the septic tanks? Can I just put it in and forget about it? Or what's the process, Senator Schrock? Just more for education of me, and...
