

TRANSCRIPT PREPARED BY THE CLERK OF THE LEGISLATURE
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FLOOR DEBATE

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I think the two parts go together; that we ought to control the representation and we ought to control the way the representation votes because, even though we're forced by circumstances to delegate the voice, we are not forced to delegate the decision, and that we should retain by enacting this amendment. Thank you.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Beutler. The question is the adoption of AM0430 to LB 282. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And a roll call vote, call of the house.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: There's been a request to place the house under call. The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.
