15 ayes, 26 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion to bracket LB 186 was not successful. I do raise the call.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have, Senator Beutler, AM0350. (Legislative Journal page 955.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, you're recognized to open on your amendment to LB 186, AM0350.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature, I would offer a compromise if the body is uncertain about this matter. And I'll simply read it to you. It leaves the law in place, except it says, junkyards located in counties that have formerly adopted a comprehensive development zone and a zoning resolution prohibiting the location of junkyards within 1,000 feet of the nearest edge of a right-of-way of any roadway of the Highway Beautification System...Control System shall be exempt from the permit system. So if the zoning is in place and if the zoning prohibits the junkyards, then fine. So I would offer that. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. You've heard the opening on AM0350 to LB 186. Open for discussion on that amendment to LB 186. Open for discussion. Senator Beutler, there are no lights on. He waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is adoption of AM0350 by Senator Beutler to LB 186. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the adoption of Beutler AM0350 to LB 186.
