SENATOR TYSON: I have a question for Senator Byars, if he would respond.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Byars, would you respond?

SENATOR BYARS: Yes, I will.

SENATOR TYSON: I would call your attention on page 2, beginning with line 5, and that...the whole thing reads: The State Board of Health shall promote and protect the health and safety of all people in Nebraska, and it shall promote and protect the environment of animals and water environments in relation to their impact on people. Would you mind explaining that to me, Senator Byars?

SENATOR BYARS: Yes, I would. Senator Tyson, that's all been stricken as part of the committee amendments. That section will now end with: in Nebraska, the State Board of Health shall promote and protect the health and safety of all people in Nebraska. The remaining language in line 4, 5 and 6 have been stricken.

SENATOR TYSON: Well, in that case, Senator Byars, in the words of Emily Latella, never mind. Mr. Clerk, would you pull that amendment that I just filed.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Tyson.

SENATOR TYSON: Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Yes, Mr. Clerk. Back to the discussion of advancement of LB 56. Seeing nobody wishing to speak, Senator Byars. He waives the opportunity to close.
