SENATOR SCHIMEK: (Laugh) Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Senator Erdman.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. Senator Schimek, I rise to give a little bit of a background on the committee as well. Not that we didn't think we should take it out because we were concerned that one of our members, mainly the senior member, wouldn't qualify under that in some situations. One of the comments that was made in the committee hearing was that if you left humans in there, mosquito sprays and other things that are actually applied to humans could then also be regulated under the Pest Control Act and some of those other areas. That was some of the discussions. And we've worked through some of those issues. So we share those same issues. But the actual comment made as to why we should leave that in there or take it out was in regards to mosquito sprays or other things like that. But we've since resolved those issues.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Erdman. Further discussion. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature. Senator Kremer, I need one clarification for sure here.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kremer, would you respond?

SENATOR KREMER: Yes.

SENATOR KREMER: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...I understand?

SENATOR KREMER: Outdoor only.
