SENATOR KREMER: No, it doesn't.

SENATOR BEUTLER: These are the animals that have the pathogenic agents, right?

SENATOR KREMER: This is just...actually, I think the description of vector is a mosquito, a cockroach, or bees, something like that. So this is outdoor control only.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Thank you, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Seeing no further lights on, Senator Kremer, did you wish to close on advancement? He waives opportunity to close. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 157 to E & R Initial. All in favor of that motion to advance vote aye, and opposed nay. We're voting on the advancement of LB 157 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 157.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 157 does advance. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.

CLERK: LB 160, a bill by Senator Kremer. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 10 of this year, referred to the Agriculture Committee for a public hearing, advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Kremer to open on LB 160.

SENATOR KREMER: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. It seems like they come all together when we have bills here. This one also comes from the Department of Agriculture. And its primary...the bill is to substitute the reference of "health certificate" throughout the act with reference to the more
