SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. President, members of the body. Senator Chambers, could I ask you a little ques...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, would you yield to a question from Senator Hartnett?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Senator Chambers, I'm looking at the committee statement. It says, the last column, it says, omits the requirement for...that adequate nutrition and potable water be provided, but adds requirement pertaining provisions of shade and shelter. I'm just looking at...why did you strike the one and so forth? I'm just...more for...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR HARTNETT: As I read, you know, the committee explanation here, I guess. Or maybe I should ask Senator Kremer.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, it's my bill and I have the answer.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Instead of the word "potable", because people even disagree as to how that word should be pronounced, I substituted "clean" water, instead of "potable" or "pottable" water. So the requirement is still there, under a different name.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. Senator Stuthman on committee amendments to LB 273.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Honorable Chair and members of the body, I would like to commend Senator Chambers for bringing this up. I do have one little bit of a concern, and I would like to ask a question of Senator Chambers.
