We are voting on the adoption of the committee amendments offered by the Agriculture Committee to LB 273. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The committee amendments are adopted. Back to discussion of the bill itself, LB 273. No lights on. Senator Chambers, do you wish to close? He waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 273 to E & R Initial. All in favor of the motion vote aye, and opposed nay. We're voting on the advancement of LB 273 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 273.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 273 does advance. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next bill, LB 274, is a bill by Senator Chambers. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 13, referred to the Agriculture Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Chambers to open on advancement of LB 274.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, once again the committee amendments become the bill. In its original form, it was designed to require commercial breeders...or, dealers to provide information on spaying and neutering to the ones they would deliver these animals to.
