February 21, 2003 LB 274

That is not in this amendment. It only licenses pet shops in the same way that dealers, commercial breeders, kennel operators, and anybody else mentioned in the statute is licensed. I was not aware, and those that I was working with were not aware, that pet shops are not licensed or regulated at this time. Thank you, Mr. President. And I will take a machine vote.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. We're still under call, and there are some senators not checked in yet. Senator Brashear, Senator Jones, Senator Bourne. Thank you, Senator Brashear. Senator Bourne, the house is under call. Senator Chambers. Chambers says we may go ahead. The question before the body is adoption of AM0506 to LB 274. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. The question before us is adoption of AM0506. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. I do raise the call. We're back on the bill itself. Senator Chambers, your light is on. He waives that opportunity to speak. The question for the body is advancement of LB 274, E & R Initial. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed nay. The motion before us is advance LB 274 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 274.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 274 does advance. Speaker Bromm, you're recognized.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. President. We're going to change the agenda very slightly here to take up a motion of Senator Baker to suspend the rules to cancel a hearing for a bill scheduled for next week. And then we'll simply adjourn after that, after another brief announcement. But so I would ask the agenda be modified to that extent.
