February 24, 2003 LB 394

LB 394 is harmonious with existing provisions of law. The changes, again, are technical in nature. And if there are no questions, I would just urge adoption of the committee amendment, AM0207.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The opening on the committee amendments offered by Senator Maxwell, Vice Chairman of the committee. Open for discussion on those amendments. Senator Hartnett, did you wish to address the committee amendments? He waives that opportunity to address them. Any further discussion on the committee amendments? I do not see any lights on. Senator Maxwell, did you wish to close? He waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is adoption of the committee amendment, offered by the Education Committee to LB 394. All in favor of the motion vote aye, and opposed nay. We're voting on the adoption of the committee amendments offered by the Education Committee. Have you all voted who care to on the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 394? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Committee amendments are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. On with discussion of the bill itself to E & R Initial. Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. President, members of the body, Senator McDonald, could I ask you a question?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Would you respond, Senator McDonald?

SENATOR McDONALD: Yes.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Will this lead to the formation of additional Class VI districts?

SENATOR McDONALD: No, it will not. It will not add more school
