SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Preister...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Let me move now to that part of this procedure that starts on line 22, on page 52, in case any of you are interested in understanding how this operates, or at least how I think it operates. And I want to be sure that I do understand it. And so I would like to...

SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...have a further dialog with Senator Quandahl when he returns to the Chamber. But under that particular subsection (6), it says, if within 30 days after its receipt...now, that's the receipt of the new insurance form proposed to be used, in fact in use, receipt by the Department of Insurance. If within 30 days after its receipt the director disapproves a filing that requires disapproval pursuant to the section that we were just talking about, then it requires notice to be sent to insurer. And then it indicates that when the insurer receives the notice of disapproval, they shall cease the use of form as soon as practicable. So they...

SPEAKER BROMM: Time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...make a determination as to practicable, for one.

SPEAKER BROMM: Time, Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And does that make sense?

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Preister.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Mr. President. I would yield my time to Senator Beutler if he would like it.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Thank you very much, Senator Preister. They should cease using the form as soon as practicable, and they
