When they'd get out there, they'd just sit up like...I'm not going to say little puppy dogs, because Mollie Rae, my heart, when I had one, was a little toy poodle, so I have to show respect to my canine friends. A little critter, sitting up on hind legs, just waving those paws, and got the tongue lolling, and showing obedience. Well, what did he do? He violated a trust. He went upstairs to the Bill Drafters Office and falsely created the illusion that our Dr. Johnson had authorized him to have an amendment drafted to a bill which our Dr. Johnson had introduced. Dr. Johnson was appropriately miffed at that. So he asked the Legislature to vote to withdraw the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Which the Legislature appropriately did. Then when a story was written by young Kevin O'Hanlon, a representative of the Associated Press, and he broke the story...but when I read it, the story in the paper, I don't see his name anywhere. Kevin O'Hanlon did it. I got my light on, so I can finish this up. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, there are no further lights on. And that was your third time, Senator, so you're recognized to close on your motion to return.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Very good. And I will close the trap on these "malfeasors." But before I do, I got to tell you a little story from the Old Testament, to keep equality and balance in the universe. There was a guy named David, who was a king. And he was a dirty, rotten scoundrel. He had a neighbor who had a
