SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...then you're into a...you might be into a "she says I did and he says he didn't" kind of situation about the waiver. But maybe they can't do it over the telephone. I don't know for sure.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Senator, I'm not sure if they would ever do it over the telephone. I'm not aware of anywhere they would. But I do know that when we do retailing over the telephone, we require that they tape those conversations so that they do have a record of a verbal agreement, so that would cover a telephone if it was ever used.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah, that would be...if that's in place, that would be...that would solve the problem. Okay. Thank you very much, Senator.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Your light is next, Senator Beutler, and he waives off. Any further discussion on AM0311? Seeing none, the Banking Committee Chair, Senator Quandahl, recognized to close on the committee amendment.
