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either have some confidence in the judiciary or you do not. And I suspect that as we have a graduation in the number of offenses or the criminal record of the individual focused entirely upon pornography that the judges are smart enough to graduate the consequence. LB 46, you correctly understand, will do exac...will provide exactly the alternative to this in the community corrections area because we will start developing programs which cost less than \$22,000 per person per year in taxpayer expense in order to handle these things appropriately. But there is no reason not to have the penalty there, and I would suggest that the present penalty is inadequate. We can quibble over whether it should be one higher or two higher. It was the judgment of the committee that at this time in our society about this scourge that people want to make a statement about, that there is nothing wrong with effecting this penalty, and I would urge that we do it. I'm not saying everything is perfectly aligned but this isn't very far out of alignment and it's a tilt in the right direction, in my opinion and apparently in the opinion of the Judiciary Committee.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Good, thank you. And I would concur. I just really wanted your perspective because, frankly, as we work through our situation over the next few months in terms of budget, we're going to...it's going to take a lot of I am going to call it communication between all committees, not just in this case Judiciary, in trying to align some of the things that we are spending money in our budget versus what is correct in the broad picture. And I see increased...

SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...communications as one way of doing it. I didn't really start out wanting to go there as I started out this conversation, but it does highlight, I think, the area that a lot of these things do cost money. And I think we need to put those...all these areas into perspective. Once again, I support this bill, but it does...you do have to realize in the short term, at least, it may increase our corrections costs, which is one of the things we've done of the last many years in good faith, if you will. But these have built in the cost and I just want to call that attention to the body. I am going to be
