SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Synowiecki.

SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: Mr. Speaker, members, I, too, rise in support of Senator Mossey's LB 111. Senator Mossey, in your introduction of your bill, you gave kind of a graphic description of a deplorable and overwhelmingly sick criminal behavior. But as you know, Senator Mossey, with your experience, a lot of these individuals that commit these types of crimes are sentenced to probation. They are sentenced to community corrections as our community corrections systems exist now within probation. And I would submit, and, Senator Mossey, I think you would agree, that our community approach to supervising this offender class, given the vulnerability and defenselessness of these victims, we do a very poor job of community supervision of these offenders under the realm of probation. We fail to address the specific rehabilitative needs of the offender. There is uniformly, almost uniformly no requirement that these offenders undertake sex-specific treatment for their offending behaviors. There is many times when these individuals are sentenced to probation, sentenced to serve their sentence in our communities. There are no provisions for having no contact with victims, no contact with children, no access to computers. I think Senator Hartnett mentioned, and I think you'll agree, that most of these are
