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defer? Okay.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Before we go on with discussion of the bill, we will let Senator Schimek just give us a brief review of the bill itself.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes. Thank you. Mr. President, members of the body, I'll be brief. The bill that is before you is the bill that provides for casino-style gambling on federally recognized Indian lands in Nebraska. And it provides for casino-style gambling in an interdiction zone that borders Nebraska two miles all the way around, except where it borders Wyoming, because Wyoming has no casinos, so therefore we are not trying to interdict monies going over to Wyoming. There could be up to five casinos in this interdiction zone if the state of Nebraska would allow it. In addition to this, we talk somewhat about the gaming revenues. And we're talking about the state tax revenues, basically, that come in on this casino-style gaming, that would be allocated part...at least in part, to the counties. And that's where I'd like the discussion to begin this morning, if we could, Mr. President. And that, I think, is adequate explanation for now.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. We will now go to discussion of LR 14CA, as reviewed by Senator Schimek. Senator Schimek, your light is first, followed by Senators Erdman, Beutler, Bourne, Hartnett, Friend, and Loudon. Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes. Thank you. Mr. President and members, yesterday, early in the discussion, Senator Bourne asked some questions about the language of the bill and...or raised some questions, perhaps, and he and I really didn't get a chance to carry on a dialogue about that. And I would like to have that occur now, if I could, if Senator Bourne would be willing to enter into that dialogue.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bourne, would you yield to a dialogue?

SENATOR BOURNE: Yes. Thank you, Senator Schimek.
