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SENATOR BRASHEAR: And the constitution makes reference. Our senior member talks about our sovereignty. Well, we just cede, we cede or give over to someone else the right to define gaming, because we define gaming by reference. And if you haven't looked up the reference, the way that we would be defining it permanently in our constitution is, "Casino gaming includes games of chance played for money, credit, or any representative of value using cards; dice; equipment; play-activated electronic, video, or mechanical gaming devices; and other methods authorized by the Legislature." So there's got to be two or three or four or five or six or seven lobbyists (laugh) in that list.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time. Thank you, Senator Brashear and Senator Erdman. Senator Tyson, followed by Senator Smith and others.

SENATOR TYSON: Senator Erdman?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Tyson, did you wish...?

SENATOR TYSON: Oh. Thank you, Senator Cudaback, members of the body. A couple of points, and I'm going to change the subject slightly from what Senator Brashear was talking about. Although that map, incidentally, leaves out Lindy, Nebraska, which is on the road to...off the road between Crofton and Niobrara. And...pardon? Lindy is your hometown? You're a Sioux? There is an illegal casino there now. Beside the point. The point that I wanted to...that I rose to make was that a lot of what I have heard here is about, we should let people vote on this. I had that thrown up to me at home just recently, a man telling me that he wanted to vote on it. And I said, you did. When did I get a chance? I said, you voted for me. You did vote for me? He says, yeah, and I think it was a mistake. (Laughter) And I said, okay, maybe so. But this is a representative form of government. We do the voting. They vote for us; we vote for what we feel is the best for the state generally and our constituency in particular. And if we don't have the courage to do that, we shouldn't be here. And one of the reasons we shouldn't be here, if that is the case, is we then don't understand that when the result of that vote takes place and we
