horse races, and we've had horse racing in this state for, what, 70 some years. I don't know what it is. You know, and I...you talk about the lobby, everyone lobbying against this. Well, you know, I've been here 11 years and I have not seen the lobby empty except on for Final Reading. There is someone for everything that we do in here that is going to either lobby for it or they are going to lobby against it. You walk from one lobbyist to the other and you will get a different story. You know, and has that happened in Iowa? Has, you know, has...have people been lobbied heavy there? I suppose they have. But when we were arguing LB 775 dollars, when it was initiated,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...do you think there wasn't heavy lobbying then? Sure, there was, and if you try to take something away from LB 775, those people will be right back here. And those are the same people that are out there supporting candidates that think the same way they do. Absolutely, there will be people contributing to your campaign. How many of you in here haven't had the State Chamber supply you with campaign money? Tobacco companies, they're here. You have the right to refuse those contributions. You don't have to take them. You don't have to listen to them. So that's why I'm telling you, the lobby, the lobby is lobbying everything. I don't know whether there is anybody out there lobbying Senator Chambers' bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.
